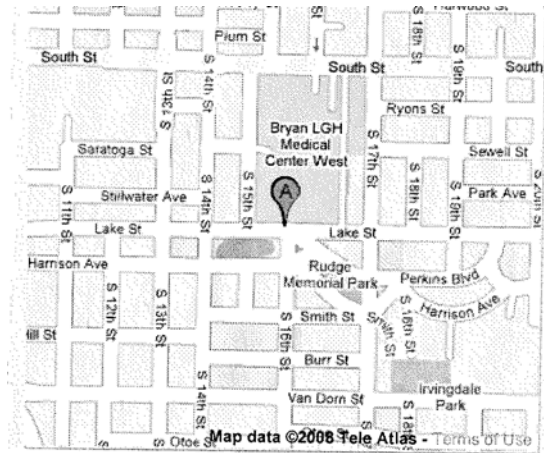

Getting to know our speaker:

Mark R. Litzow, MD

Dr. Mark Litzow is the director of the Blood and Marrow Transplant Program and the Myeloid Disease-Oriented Group in the Division of Hematology at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN and an Associate Professor of Medicine in the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine.

Dr. Litzow attended medical school at the University of Chicago and then trained in Internal Medicine and Hematology/Oncology at the Mayo Clinic. He spent a year as a Mayo Foundation Scholar studying blood and marrow transplantation at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center in Seattle, WA. He has been the co-chair of the Leukemia Committee of the Eastern Cooperative Oncology Group since 2001 and is currently the Vice-Chair for North America for the Center for International Blood and Marrow Transplant Research.

Dr. Litzow's research interests include clinical trials for acute and chronic leukemia including blood and marrow transplantation, and transplantation for solid tumors and supportive care of blood and marrow transplant patients. He has been awarded RO1 funding for the use of autologous dendritic cell therapy for chronic myelogenous leukemia. Dr. Litzow is a member of multiple professional societies related to hematology/oncology and blood and marrow transplantation. He is the author of over 100 manuscripts and several book chapters, the vast majority of which are related to leukemia and blood and marrow transplantation.
